[PROPOSED] RESOLUTION

WHEREAS on July 22, 2014, the Executive Director of the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission (California Energy Commission) provided his recommendation, attached hereto as “Exhibit A,” to U.S. Energy Raters Association (USERA), that the Commission:

(1) certify USERA as a Provider under the California Home Energy Rating System (HERS) Program, to administer the HERS Provider program previously approved to be administered by USERA for field verification and diagnostic testing for alterations to existing buildings, as required by the 2013 Building Energy Efficiency Standards, pursuant to Public Resources Code section 24942, and California Code of Regulations, title 20, sections 1670 et seq., 1674, subd. (c); and

(2) certify USERA Data Registry as it meets the requirements of a residential data registry in California Code of Regulations, title 24, section 10-109 and Joint Reference Appendix JA7, of the 2013 Building Energy Efficiency Standards, and

(3) certify Enalaysys as a Third Party Quality Control (TPQC) program as it meets the requirements of collecting data from participating installers for each installation completed for energy compliance. Enalaysys provides data checking analysis to evaluate the validity and accuracy of the data to independently determine whether compliance has been achieved. Enalaysys shall also provide functionality that allows Energy Commission staff to query retained data or documents for analysis. Enalaysys meets the requirements of residential data collection of the 2013 Joint Reference Appendix RA2.4.3, RA2.7 and the 2013 Building Energy Efficiency Standards.

WHEREAS the July 22, 2014, Business Meeting was the first available meeting, after the Executive Director provided his recommendation, for the Commission to consider this matter;

THEREFORE the Commission confirms the Executive Director’s findings and adopts his recommendation, and:

(1) certifies USERA as a HERS Provider to administer the USERA HERS Provider program for field verification and diagnostic testing for alterations to existing buildings as required by the 2013 Building Energy Efficiency Standards; and

(2) certifies USERA Data Registry, as required by California Code of Regulations, title 24, section 10-109 and Joint Reference Appendix JA7, of the 2013 Building Energy Efficiency Standards.

(3) certifies Enalays as a Third Party Quality Control (TPQC), to administer the program by collecting data, checking analysis for validity, checking accuracy of the data and independently determining whether compliance has been achieved as required by the 2013 Joint Reference Appendix RA2.4.3, RA2.7 and the 2013 Building Energy Efficiency Standards.
